PASTORAL STRUCTURE

The pastoral structure at Priory School is very much based on a family structure;

Tutor group = immediate family

Year group = extended family

Whole school = local community



Events to reinforce this structure include; Tutor time occurs twice a day. We keep the same Tutor and Progress Leader with the students throughout the 5 years at Priory to maintain continuity of support and to ensure every student is truly known by their pastoral team.

Assemblies are delivered in year groups each week. Key messages, celebrations and opportunities are shared in assemblies. Whole school assemblies occur termly.

Rewards are issued in assemblies where students receive recognition and their achievements are celebrated by the year group.

the progress of year groups and individuals is overseen by Progress Coordinators, Progress Leaders and Tutors to ensure recognition is given and support is offered where appropriate.
