Dear Parent/Carer

After previous successful expeditions to Norway and Iceland, I am delighted to be able to inform you that we are able to offer your child the chance to join our new expedition to Kenya in March 2024, to spend time volunteering in a school in the developing area of Nakuru.

The expedition is organised by African Adventures, who specialise in educational expeditions for young people in the UK. African Adventures' partner schools in Africa provide an education for children from under-privileged backgrounds and have volunteers to support the long-term development of the schools. Your child will be able to choose to support the school in a teaching and sports coaching role or a building/renovation role. Whilst they will undoubtedly make a difference, your child stands to learn so much about the wider world during this challenging and exciting experience.

Most students raise the majority of their expedition costs through fundraising, which helps to develop their enterprise skills, and Priory School and African Adventures will provide lots of support and ideas to help with this, including online workshops and fundraising advice. More details will be given about this at the information evening.

The 9-night expedition will depart on 30 March 2024 and will cost £1,920. This includes return flights, accommodation, food, transport, project costs, travel insurance, ATOL protection and the Rift Valley Adventure Day, where volunteers will have the chance to see some of Kenya's famous wildlife at Lake Nakuru National Park before conducting scientific experiments at the Equator and visiting the world famous Thomson Falls. **Spending money, visa and vaccination costs are not included in this total.**

The trip is ATOL protected and African Adventures has organised trips and expeditions for thousands of students in the UK. The organisation is also a member of the School Travel Forum and has been awarded the Learning Outside the Classroom Quality Badge.

We would like to invite you to an information evening at **6pm on Thursday 17th November 2022**, where parents and students will be able to find out more and ask any questions about this exciting opportunity.

Places on the expedition will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and more information will be given at the information evening about booking on to the trip. A deposit of £195.00 will be required by 1st December to secure your child's place.

We are very much looking forward to seeing you at the information evening.
