Game-changer Pursuit Week - 6th - 10th July 2026

This letter is to outline the final information for trips and meeting times during Pursuit Week 2026 for your child.

Y10 students must register on-site every day by 8.30am in the Lower gym for registration. The only day they do not meet here is on Thursday 9th July when they will be going to Thorpe Park.

On Thursday 9th July - the Thorpe Park trip day - please ensure your child is at the B&Q car park in Fratton by 8am latest. Please ensure they are on time so the trip can leave at 8.15am. The trip will then return by 4.30pm, traffic permitting.

On the Bowling/Spinnaker trip students will be dismissed from Gunwharf Quays at 3pm unless you have filled out the form to say they need to walk back to school with teachers. Lunch will be provided for all students at the bowling alley on this day.

Please ensure your child brings plenty of water throughout the week and lunch on their trip days. FSM students will be provided with a lunch each day. On the days where the provision is on-site the canteen will be open as usual. The week is non-school uniform, however, we advise sports clothing and trainers to be worn. We insist on no sliders, or flip-flops, as many activities need closed-toe shoes to participate safely in.

If you have not yet filled in the permission slip for your student to participate in the trips please do so via this link. Failure to do so may result in your child not attending the trips during the week.
